## - Our Purpose & 10 Market Rules -

## <u>Our Purpose:</u> To give local farmers a venue to market their wholesome agricultural products directly to the consumer easily, safely, and with joy.

- 1. Only vendors with completed and approved applications may utilize the Marion County Farmer's Market. Applications are to be completed on an annual basis, expire on December 31<sup>st</sup>, and require the completion of the following:
  - a. Reading and understanding of all rules, policies, etc.
  - b. Signature of potential vendor and date of signature
  - c. List of all produce, other food products, and hand-crafted items intended to be sold
- **2.** Advertised Market Hours are Friday-Sunday, Sunrise NOON. NOTE: Approved vendors may use the market throughout the week, but will likely be more successful selling during advertised hours.
- **3.** Once an application is completed and received, it must then be approved by the *Farmer's Market Committee* or its designated representative(s). Once approved, the vendor will be issued a *VENDOR CARD* that must be made available upon request to all involved authorities. **NO CARD = NO SELLING AT THE MARKET.**
- 4. Reselling of produce and other approved food products is allowed so long as vendors clearly display, at all times, signage showing where the current produce or products being sold were produced and who produced them. Reusable signs will be provided to all approved vendors. Vendors are subject to relevant inspections to verify the source of their produce and products.
- 5. There will be <u>no fixed prices</u> at the Marion County Farmers Market. It is at the discretion of the vendors to market their produce and other food products at the prices they see fit. - 6. Vendors must keep their areas clean and orderly at all times and ensure there is no trash, signage, boxes, vehicles, trailers or other personal items left on the premises overnight. The Marion County Farmer's Market nor its management will be held responsible for lost, stolen, or misplaced items.
- 7. Only fruits, vegetables, & other food products that meet the requirements listed and referenced to in the *TDA*'s Farmers Market State Compliance Guide (provided) may be sold at the Marion County Farmer's Market.
- **8.** HANDCRAFTED ITEMS: These items can be sold <u>SO LONG AS</u> they are crafted by hand and sold by the vendor. If this rule is violated, the vendor selling the items will forfeit their Vendor Card and will not be allowed to sell at the market for a full calendar year from the date of the initial violation.
- 9. Only service animals will be allowed at the Marion County Farmer's Market. No other animals are allowed.
- 10. These rules and policies are subject to change by the *Farmer's Market Committee* at any time. The *Farmer's Market Committee* reserves the right to deny or revoke a vendor's application, vendor card, and permission to use the premises at any time and for any reason without discourse.
